HORIZON-WIDERA-2024-ERA-01-05: Experimentation and exchange of good practices for value creation

Rationale:

- Need to **translate available scientific knowledge and research results** to **innovative solutions**, including technological as well as non-technological and social innovations, in the market, in society and for better policy making

Objectives:

- **More experimentation, peer learning and testing** of new models as well as trying out good practices in different environments is needed
- Making research results more adapted to the **needs** of citizens and communities

Expected Outcome:

- Value creation and transfer to the economy and society by increased interlinkages and cooperation between knowledge valorisation actors in line with **ERA Action 7 (EU Valorisation Platform)**
- **New solutions** to societal and economic challenges by stronger uptake and deployment of research results, including through the involvement of citizens and civil society
- **Improvements** of structures, strategies, practices and skills for knowledge valorisation through sustainable reforms and new initiatives
- Develop **policy recommendations** and links to other relevant actions.

Evaluation Summary Report – Positive Comments

Excellence

- *The methodology approach has been very well specified in terms of conceptual approach, underlying tools and theories adapted to the project in a meaningful way is extensive use of the existing.*
- The proposal explains in detail on how open science is used for knowledge valorisation

Impact:

- *The proposal details well on specific possible examples that can be considered tangible impact from this specific project design.*
- *The scale and significance of the project's contribution to outcomes and impacts in terms of the key performance indicators and involvement of quadruple helix partners other than universities are well defined*

Implementation

- *Capacity and role of each Participant and the extent to which the consortium as a whole brings together the necessary expertise.*

Evaluation Summary Report – Negative Comments

Excellence

- The innovative elements regarding needs of industry, systemic solutions, business strategies, policy recommendations and tools aimed at encouraging social transition and cocreation experiments towards sustainable XXX Strategy have not been sufficiently developed. .
- The proposed methodology is good in terms of operational activities and the three phased approach. However, the way in which the new construct will lead to **successful matching** of applicants has not been sufficiently presented.
- The challenges in terms of the chosen methodology and
- credible measures to overcome them have not been sufficiently specified with regard to societal engagement in knowledge valorisation.

Impact

- The potential barriers to expected outcomes and impacts including appropriate mitigation measures have not been sufficiently specified in the document.
- The management of intellectual property and foreseen protection measures are insufficiently specified in the proposal
- The scale and significance of the proposal in terms of baselines, regional actors, inter-sectoral interaction, knowledge valorisation and new career pathways, has been insufficiently developed. .

Implementation

- The critical risks for project implementation and the accompanying proposed risk-mitigation measures are insufficiently defined in the proposal.
- The project consortium is comprised of partners from diverse sectors and fields of expertise covering most of the entire value chain. However, the involvement of the tech transfer community is inadequately presented.
