



Subdirección General de Internacionalización de la Ciencia y la Investigación (SGInCI)

- El impulso y la coordinación de las actividades de promoción de la investigación y la cultura científicas.
- El impulso de la participación española en los programas de fomento de la I+D+I promovidos por la Unión Europea, en el ámbito de sus competencias.
- La planificación estratégica, coordinación, desarrollo, seguimiento y representación de la participación española en grandes instalaciones y organismos científico-tecnológicos de carácter internacional.
- La cooperación internacional en materia de Investigación, la formulación conjunta con los órganos del departamento y la coordinación de la posición española en foros internacionales, y la propuesta de designación de quienes hayan de representar a España en los organismos internacionales responsables de los correspondientes programas.
- La coordinación de la participación española en la elaboración y seguimiento de las políticas europeas en materia de I+D+I, incluido el Programa Marco de Investigación e Innovación, y la representación española en otros programas, foros y organizaciones de carácter europeo e internacional competentes en el diseño de políticas en materia de I+D+I.
- Las funciones atribuidas al Ministerio de Ciencia e Innovación en la gestión de programas operativos cofinanciados por fondos de la Unión Europea, en el ámbito de sus competencias.

Gestión de Horizonte Europa



Article 179

(ex Article 163 TEC)

1. The Union shall have the objective of strengthening its scientific and technological bases by achieving a European research area in which researchers, scientific knowledge and technology circulate freely, and encouraging it to become more competitive, including in its industry, while promoting all the research activities deemed necessary by virtue of other Chapters of the Treaties.
2. For this purpose the Union shall, throughout the Union, encourage undertakings, including small and medium-sized undertakings, research centres and universities in their research and technological development activities of high quality; it shall support their efforts to cooperate with one another, aiming, notably, at permitting researchers to cooperate freely across borders and at enabling undertakings to exploit the internal market potential to the full, in particular through the opening-up of national public contracts, the definition of common standards and the removal of legal and fiscal obstacles to that cooperation.
3. All Union activities under the Treaties in the area of research and technological development, including demonstration projects, shall be decided on and implemented in accordance with the provisions of this Title.


