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<b>Short Description of the Project idea (if foreseeable)</b>	A research project focusing on child-robot interaction (CRI) in learning. We are particularly interested in learning in family and school contexts. The project covers the following research themes: Verbal and multimodal interaction in CRI Affective reactions to CRI Problem-solving situations in CRI Learning outcomes in CRI Parent's and teacher's role as a facilitator or as a mediator in CRI In this project we study human–robot interaction (HRI). We focus particularly on child-robot interaction (CRI) in learning, in family and school contexts. Our objective is to study how verbal and multimodal interaction takes place between humans and robots. We are interested in how children respond verbally and emotionally to robots in learning situations as well as what kind of problem-solving situations children have in communicating with robots. In learning situations, the role of the parent or teacher changes to a facilitator or a mediator in the communication.
