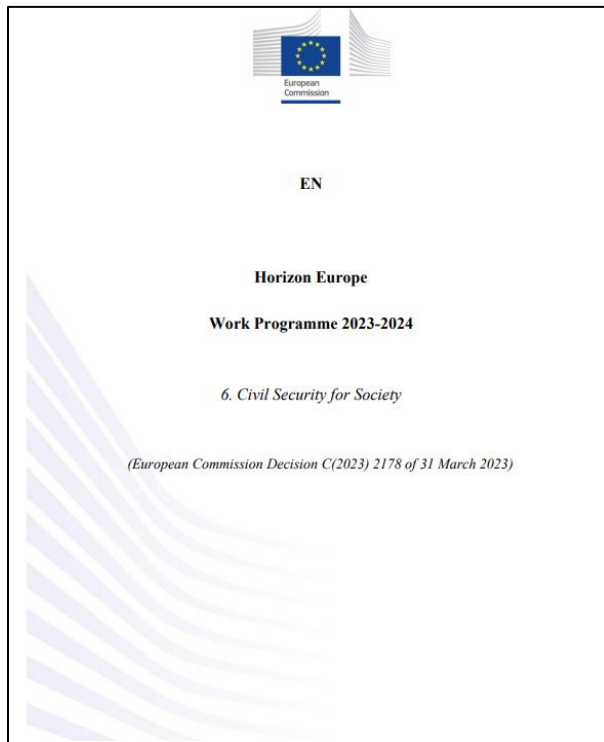
Participación española en Clúster 3 (2021-2022)

- España participa en 63 proyectos de 96 financiados (65,6%)
- Coordina **15 de ellos (15,6%)**
- **Participación de usuarios finales españoles en 43 de 63 proyectos con socios españoles (68%)**
- **2021-2022: España 3er país (retorno económico: 12,62% UE, tras Grecia e Italia.**

Convocatoria 2022: España ha sido el 2º país (14,1% retorno UE), tras Grecia (14,8%)

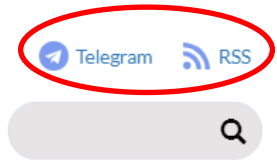

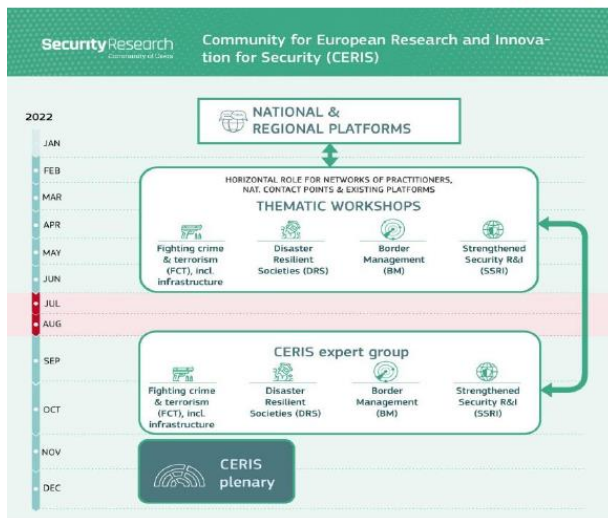
