- ✓ explain how expertise of relevant industry sectors and other healthcare stakeholders are integrated.
- ✓ (as relevant) approach to engage with regulatory and health technology assessment bodies
- ✓ (as relevant) describe how patients, learned societies and healthcare providers' perspectives are incorporated
- ✓ where required by the call conditions, include a strategy to ensure affordability, availability and accessibility of products and services based, or partly based, on project results.
- ✓ describe how the participants complement one another (and cover the value chain, where appropriate) and create a successful public private partnership
