Misión cancer: Aspectos diferenciales

AMBICIÓN: La convocatoria debe fijar objetivos ambiciosos porque es competitiva; menos ambición reduciría el nivel de excelencia e innovación.

ÁMBITO DE APLICACIÓN: similar “estándar” Horizonte Europa, importantes diferencias:

- Implicar sistemáticamente a los ciudadanos, incluidos los pacientes y sus cuidadores.
- Participación mayor de lo habitual de disciplinas y sectores diferentes.
- Mayor atención a: generación de resultados tangibles, atención al impacto social, TRLs altos, implementación e investigación aplicada, soluciones orientadas a atención sanitaria.
- Participación de Regiones / Estados Miembros y los Países Asociados, si adecuado.

AGRUPACIÓN: formación de clústeres de proyectos

PORTFOLIO : CANCER-01-01, CANCER-01-02 : “grants will be awarded to applications not only in order of ranking but also to at least one application that fully addresses cancer in children, adolescents or young adults (meaning people between birth and the age of 24), provided that the application attains all thresholds”.
