
# **Getting the Concept Right for the Call**

- These doctoral programmes will respond to well-identified needs in various R&I areas
- Expose the researchers to the academic and non-academic sectors
- Offer training in research-related
- Offer transferable skills and competences relevant for innovation and longterm employability
  - leadership,
  - independency,
  - creativity,
  - communication,
  - entrepreneurship,
- Sinergy among partners


# The Evaluation – Step 1





#### Independent reports

- Evaluators selected based on keywords
- Be aware Potential different profiles
- Each expertise scores several proposals in a short time
- Easy reading and clear ideas help
- Not known each other




#### Vice-chair as Rapporteur

- Rapporteur elaborates the consensus report
- Evaluators meet each other for discussion (chat)

# The Evaluation – Step 2

Consensus report Strengths, weaknesses



Consensus report scoring



Proposals scoring above 70% are discussed and ranked in a final planel of Vice-chairs

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

### Excelence (50%)

- Quality and level of novelty
- Inter/multidisciplinary
- Quality and appropriateness of the training
- Quality of the supervision
- Quality of the integration in the team/institution

Impact (30%)

- Enhancing the future career prospects of the researcher after the fellowship
- Quality of exploitation and dissemination plan

Implementation (20%)

- Coherence and effectiveness of the work plan
- Allocation of tasks and resources
- Appropriateness of the management structure and procedures
- Risk management
- Appropriateness of the infrastructure of the institutional environment

To be considered for funding, the proposal must score above a certain **threshold** for each individual award criterion, and above an overall threshold for all of them together

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- Successful proposals high scoring in all criteria.
- Frequent mistake consider that the project (criteria 1) is the most important part of the proposal and criteria 2 and 3 are not so relevant.
- Take care of the implementation and impact parts of the proposal.
- Essential good synergy among partners for giving good training.

- 4 very good. The proposal addresses the criterion very well, but a small number of shortcomings are present.
- 5 Excellent. The proposal successfully addresses all relevant aspects of the criterion shortcomings are minor.

- Show the uniqueness of your doctorate programme
- Identify how the consortium will deliver the overall research goal and main objectives through the network
- Future professional benefits of the graduate students
  - employability

# **Integrated Research and Training Strategy – Key Points**

- Provide a credible and integrated strategy
- Clearly identify research tools and facilities, complementary training across the network – transferrable skills
- Implement convincing continuous progress monitoring
- Implement protocols for communication across the network

# Management, Financial, Institutional – Key Points

- Identify the administrative units responsible for the fellows
- Financial plan, risks and contingency plans
- Clearly define the integration plan
- Intellectual properties plan
