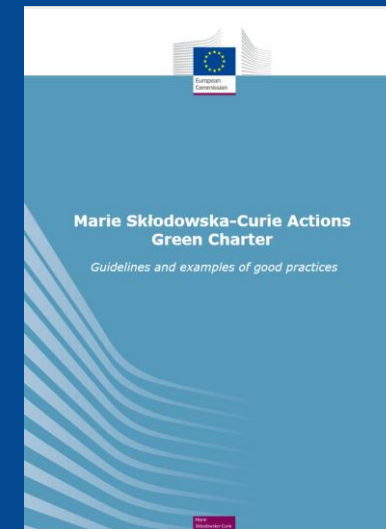

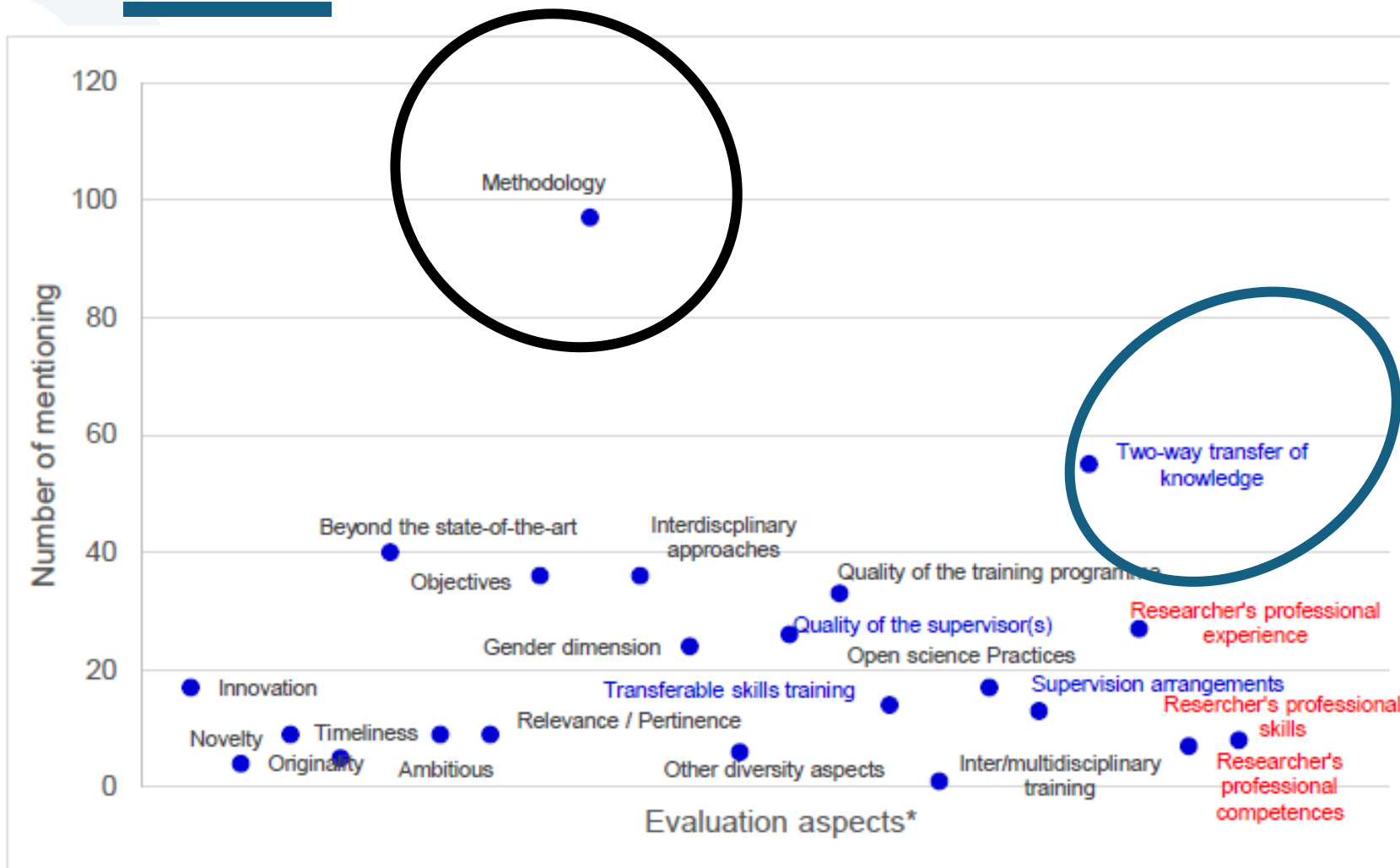

# Errores a evitar - Excelencia

---

- Confundir objetivos con outputs o entregables.
- No identificar explícitamente el «gap in knowledge».
- Hipótesis ausente o formulada de forma vaga.
- Metodología descriptiva sin justificación de por qué funcionará.
- No explicar por qué ESTE grupo / ESTA institución.
- No explicar el “two-way transfer” de conocimiento.
- Ausencia de “soft skills” en el plan de formación.
- Currículum no alineado con el proyecto.
- Dimensión de género ignorada cuando es claramente relevante.

# Debilidades - Excelencia

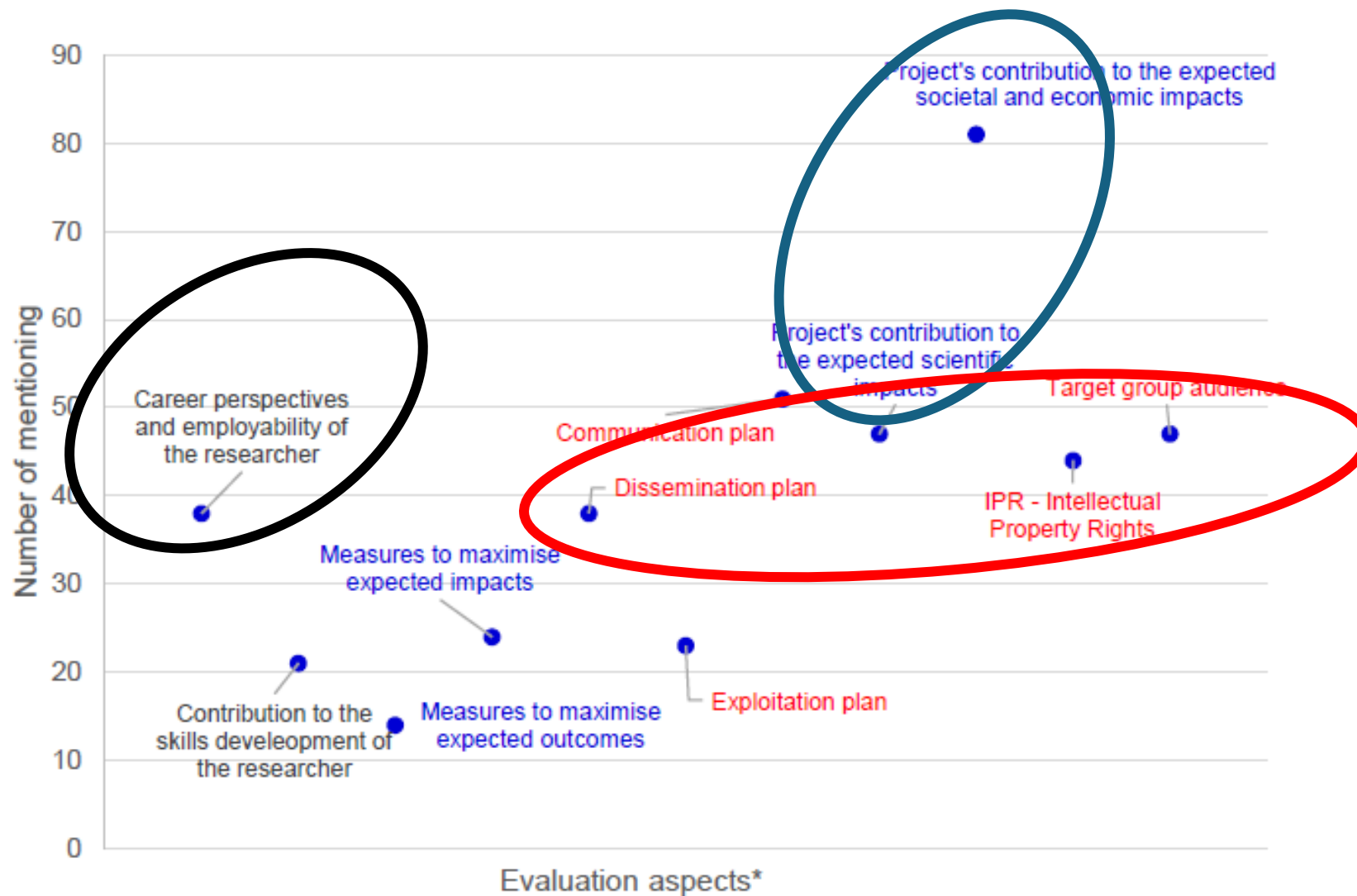

# Errores a evitar - Impacto

---

- No referirse a habilidades concretas que se adquirirán (técnicas + “soft”)
- No explicar como te prepara para el siguiente paso en tu carrera.
- Confundir “training” durante el proyecto (1.3) vs impacto del mismo en tu carrera (2.1).
- No identificar correctamente audiencias de las actividades de comunicación y diseminación.
- No abordar consideraciones de Propiedad Intelectual.
- Exagerar en el impacto (si no lo hay, decirlo).

# Errores a evitar - Impacto

---

- Falta de consistencia en el Gantt Chart respect a WPs, deliverables, milestones y secondments /NAPs.
- Evaluación de riesgos y planes de contingencia parciales (científicos y de gestión) o demasiado genéricos.
- Falta información sobre el equipo más allá del supervisor y de los planes de integración para el/la fellow.
- No justificar secondments y/o NAPs.



# Recomendaciones prácticas

---

No es sólo un proyecto de investigación, hay que tener en consideración:

Que es una oportunidad para de adquirir nuevos conocimiento a través de tu proyectos de investigación

El lugar correcto y con la persona correcta (supervisor/-a)

La adquisición de nuevas capacidades y competencias

## **Evaluación:**

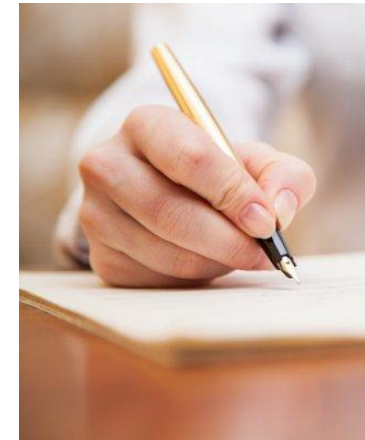
- Aunque los criterios tienen distinto peso (50%, 30% y 20%) hay que ir a por el 100% en todos
- Seguir las *templates*
- Usar imágenes y figuras tanto como sea posible (deben ser legibles e informativas)
- Palabras clave: *innovation, research career, international collaboration, interdisciplinary, intersectorality*

## **Sobre el proyecto**

- Investigación y formación
- Plan de trabajo realista (¡recursos disponibles!)
- Bien estructurado, cuidar el “story-telling”
- Encaje *fellow-supervisor-host*

## **Sobre el CV del candidat@ a fellow:**

- CV no tiene que ser perfecto. Las colaboraciones, *secondments* y formaciones deben abordar necesidades.
- Tener en cuenta la empleabilidad tras la implementación del proyecto (en todos los sectores)
