# Mono-beneficiary action:

new or existing national, regional, international schemes for <u>doctoral</u> training & <u>postdoctoral</u> fellowships

#### Focus:

best practice, high standards & excellent working conditions, sustainable structuring effects, encouraging synergies with other EU funds

### **COFUND – For whom?**



Single legal entity established in an EU Member State



Single legal entity established in HE associated country



Minimum of 3 researchers must be recruited





Part-time allowed for personal or family reasons




**Secondments** up to 1/3 of fellowship duration



COFUND **Seal of Excellence** for applications scoring ≥85%




# Total budget of cofunded programme



2. General Description & Info on Beneficiary (max 2 pages)

3. Table of Contents (1 page)

4. Excellence

5. Impact

6. Implementation

Sections 4-6 (max 30 pages)

# **Proposal Structure Part B2 - Annexes**

- 1. Ethical Aspects
- 2. Partner Organisations
- 3. Environmental considerations MSCA Green Charter

No overall page limit

Exception: max ½ page / associated/implementing partner
