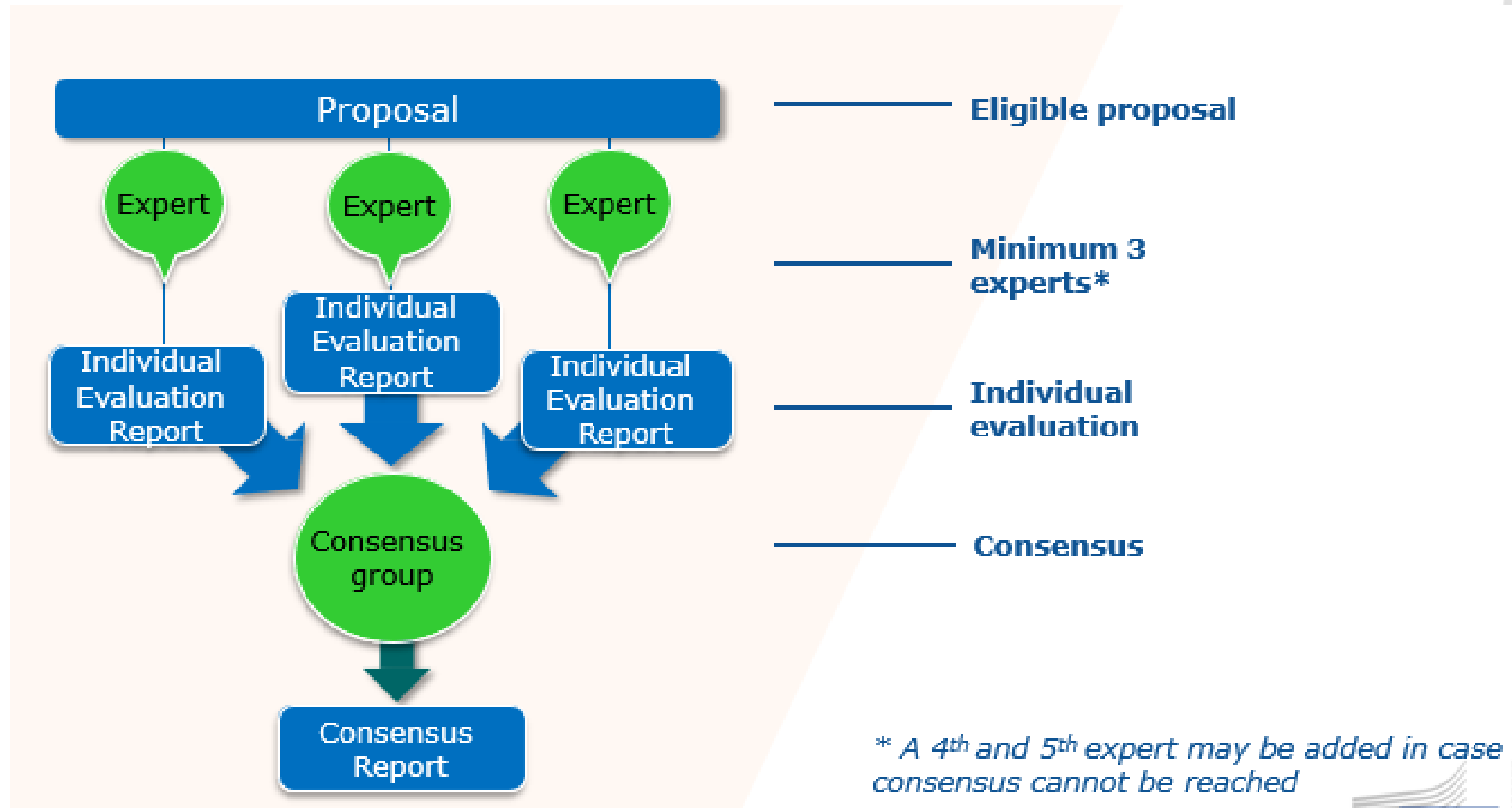

- Todos los Expertos firman un contrato antes de comenzar a trabajar (confidencialidad y ausencia de conflictos de interés)

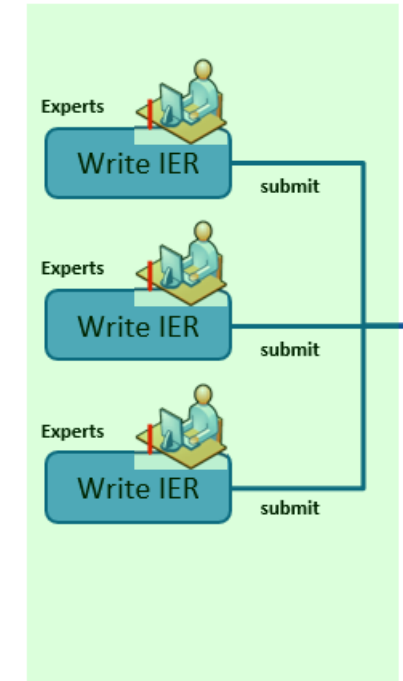

Individual Evaluation Reports (IER)

- ✓ Preparado por cada experto independiente en solitario de forma remota
- ✓ Lectura de la propuesta y evaluación
- ✓ Sin discutirla ni compartirla con nadie
- ✓ Evaluación sólo en base a los criterios de evaluación establecidos
- ✓ Evaluación sólo en base al contenido de la propuesta
- ✓ Redacción del IER y enviarlo por el SEP

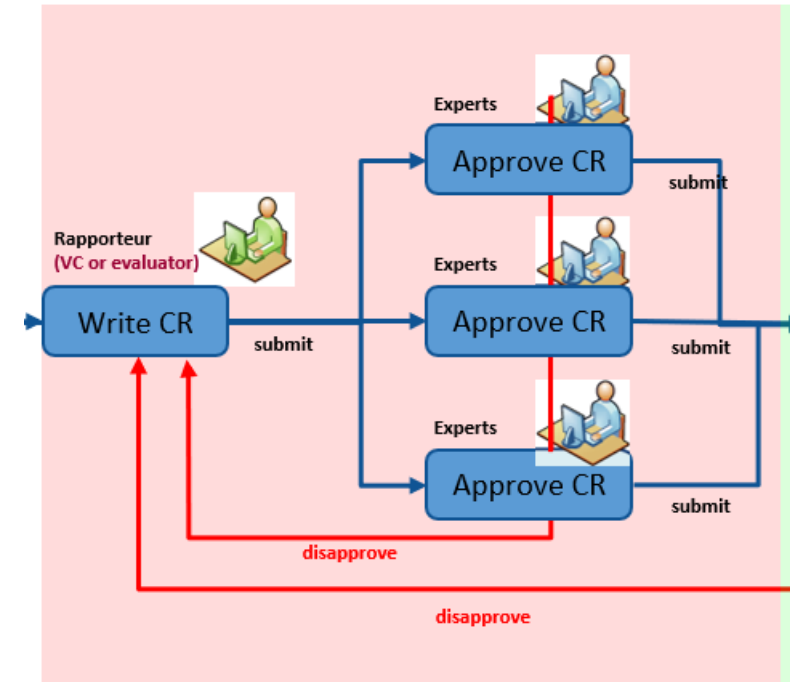

Evaluators' Consensus

- ✓ Puesta en común de los 3 IERs no una media
- ✓ Acuerdo en los comentarios.
- ✓ Con los comentarios acordados, se acuerda la puntuación
- ✓ Vice-Chairs hacen seguimiento del intercambio
- ✓ En caso de que cueste alcanzar consenso:
 - Chair puede convocar videoconferencias
 - Chair puede incorporar otros expertos

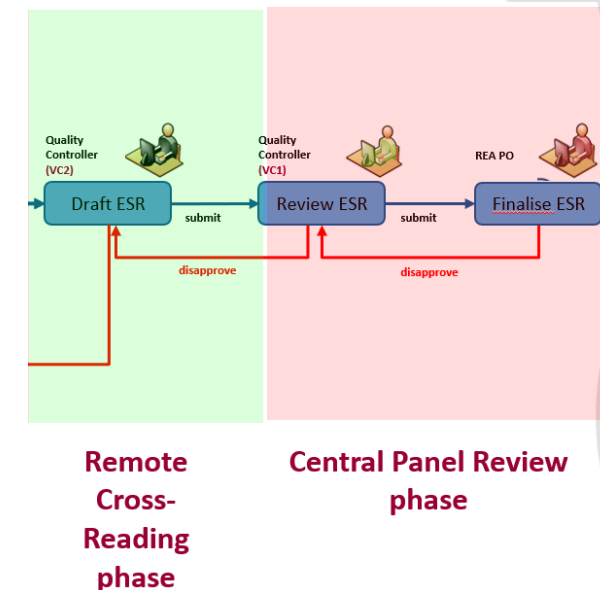

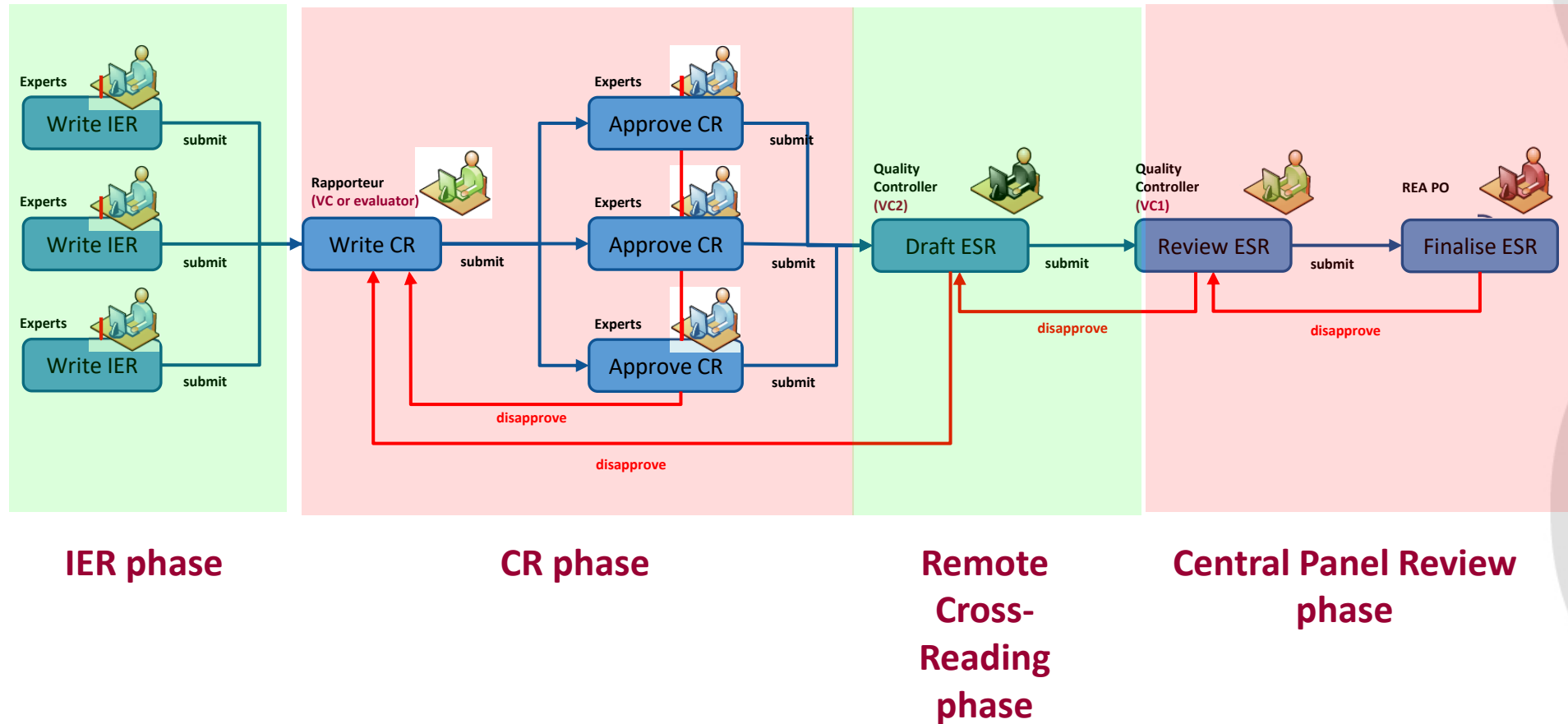
Consensus Report (CR) -> Evaluation Summary report (ESR)

- ✓ CR redactados por los Vice-chairs
- ✓ Validado por los expertos independientes antes de convertirse en el borrador de ESR
- ✓ Otro Vice-Chair realiza un primer control de calidad:
 - Las puntuaciones deben ser coherentes con los comentarios.
 - Los comentarios deben ser específicos del criterio relevante.
 - Las fortalezas y debilidades no deben contradecirse.
 - No se permite la doble penalización.
 - Evite dar consejos sobre cómo mejorar la propuesta
- ✓ Chairs y Co-chairs realizan un segundo control de calidad presencialmente:
 - Confirmar que los distintos ESRs están abordados de manera equitativa
- ✓ ESR y ranking con REA presencialmente



Flujo de trabajo

- ✓ Observador tiene acceso a todo el proceso y prepara informe de evaluación que se facilita al Comité de Programa junto con los resultados de la convocatoria

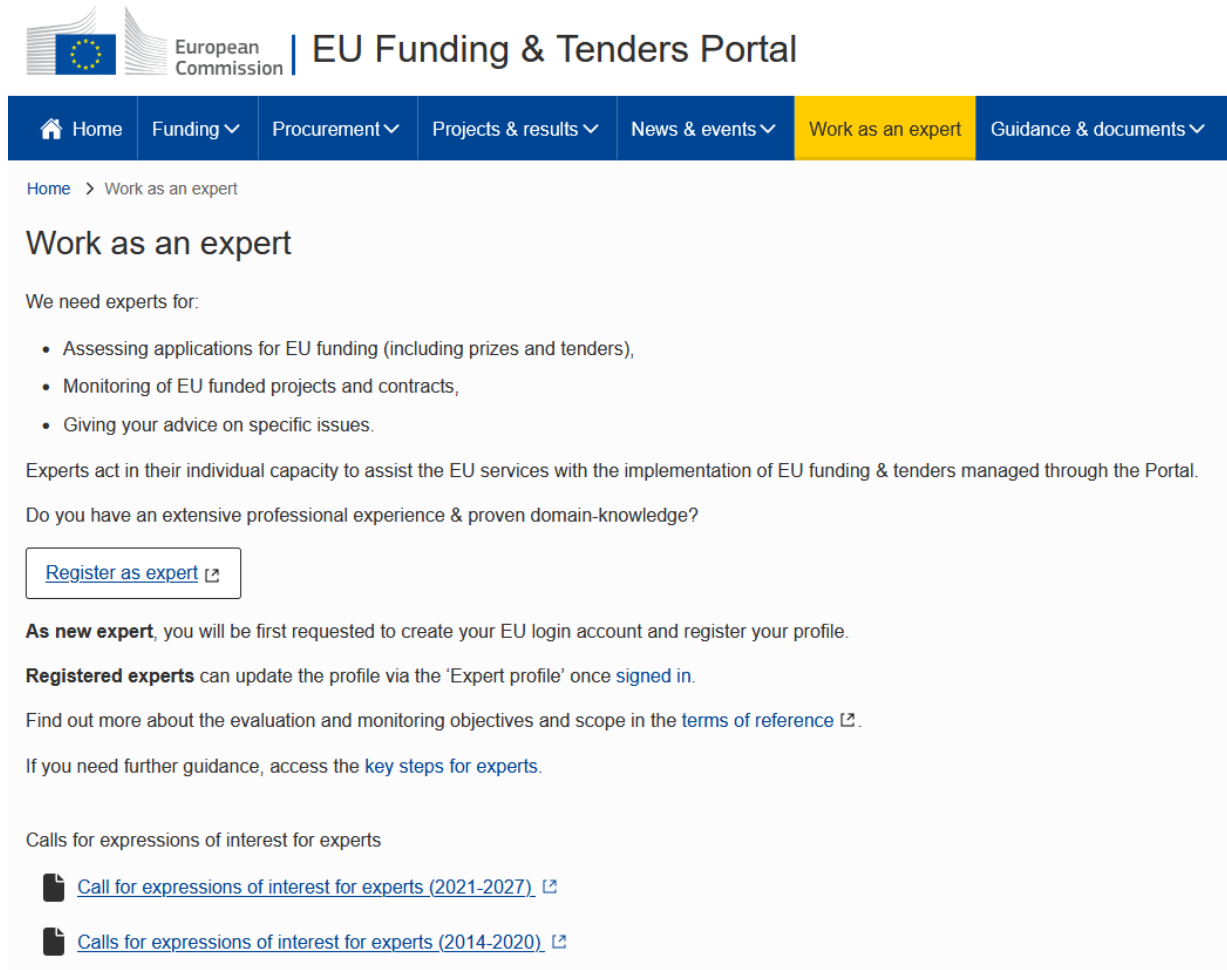


Crerios de evaluaci3n

Criteria	Weight	Priority (ex.aequo)
Excellence	50%	1
Impact	30%	2
Implementation	20%	3

1. The proposals will be prioritised according to the scores they have been awarded for the criterion ‘Excellence’. When these scores are equal, priority will be based on scores for the criterion ‘Impact’.
2. If necessary, the **gender balance among the supervisors** named in the proposal will be used as a factor for prioritisation.
3. If a distinction still cannot be made, the **panel may decide** to further prioritise by considering other factors such as environmental considerations in line with the **MSCA Green Charter, gender and other diversity aspects in the research activities, participation of the non-academic sector** (including involvement of SMEs), **geographical diversity, international cooperation, favourable employment and working conditions or relationship to the Horizon Europe objectives in general**. These factors will be documented in the panel report.

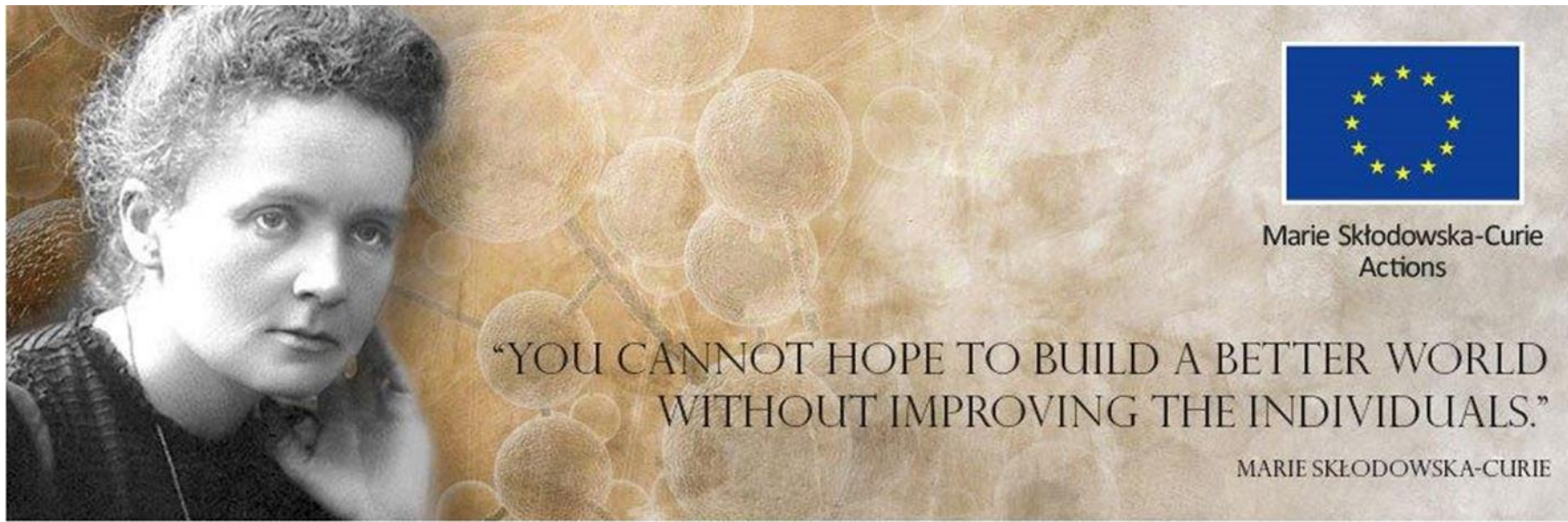
