EIC Pathfinder Challenges – Guidelines and submission available

The EIC Pathfinder Challenges Call for Proposals are now open, with deadline Oct 27th, 2021.

Quick Summary

Type of Action: Research and Innovation Action *Funding Rate*: 100% Eligible costs *Eligibility Conditions*:

<u>Mono-beneficiary</u>: The legal entities may for example be universities, research organisations, SMEs, startups, natural persons. In the case of monobeneficiary projects, mid-caps and larger companies will not be permitted.

Multi-beneficiary:

- **Two entities**: Consortia of two must have independent legal entities from two different Member States or Associated Countries.
- Three entities or more: Consortia of three or above follow standard rules: at least one legal entity must be from a Member State and independent legal entities from three different Member States or Associated Countries.

Proposal Template: Specific, in terms of content and limit of pages for the three sections Excellence, Impact and Implementation (25 Pages).

Evaluation Form: Specific *Relevant document*: EIC Pathfinder Challenge Guidelines, available under Topic Conditions and Documents section of the <u>Call for Proposals</u> or via the <u>EIC website dedicated webpage</u> *Deadline* Oct 27th, 2021 (17.00 CET)

EIC Pathfinder Open – Participation Rate



25 May was the first deadline of the EIC Pathfinder Open call. EC received 908 consortia applications (5341 participants in total) calling for more than €2.7 billion of grant support. This is a higher number than the Pathfinder calls under EIC pilot and preceding FET Open programme. Applicants are coming from 60 countries and are mainly from Higher Education bodies and research institutions, but with a relatively high number from the private sector (29% of participants, of which 67% are SMEs). With €168 million budget allocated to this call, it is expected that approximately 55 applications will be funded. The evaluation process has begun and will be finalised at the end of September with the selection of interdisciplinary teams of researchers to realise their radical visions for science-towards-technology breakthroughs.
