
General Aspects MSCA

MSCA Doctoral Networks 2022: Objectives

- ✓ Networks training doctoral candidates, responding to well-identified needs in various R&I areas (bottom-up)
- ✓ Expose researchers to the **academic and non-academic sectors**.
- ✓ Offer research-related training, as well as competences relevant for innovation and long-term employability.
- ✓ Focus on research and transferable skills, inter-sectoral secondments, career development plan, supervision, internationalisation/attractiveness.

MSCA DN 2022: Main novelties

- ✓ Addition of resubmission restrictions and Gender Equality Plan.
- Updated consortium requirement for DN-ID: Providing an alternative to multiple recruitment in ID.
- ✓ Updated secondment limitation for DN-ID and DN-JD: secondment limitations not applicable for DN-ID and DN-JD.
- ✓ Steering board replaced by Supervisory board.

MSCA DN 2022: Main features



DURATION 4 years



COMPOSITION Min 3 organisations in 3 different EU MS or HE AC (at least 1 MS)



FELLOWSHIP Between 3 and 36 months



BUDGET 360 PM for regular DN; 540 PM for Industrial Doctorates & Joint Doctorates



MSCA DN 2022: Modalities

Doctoral Networks (Standard)

A consortium of at least 3 entities offering innovative doctoral training in academia and/or non academia

Industrial Doctorates

Doctoral candidates step outside academia to develop skills in industry and business by being jointly supervised by the academic and nonacademic organisations

Joint Doctorates

Highly integrated doctoral training leading to joint, double or multiple doctoral degrees and with the candidate selection and supervision jointly done by the degree-awarding institutions



MSCA DN 2022: Features

Size:

• Up to 360 person-month (standard) + 180 **additional** person-month as incentive for Industrial or Joint Doctorates

Duration:

- **Programme**: Max 48 months
- Fellowship: Between 3 and 36 months
- Secondments: Up to 1/3 of fellowship duration for standard DN and with no upper limit for Industrial and Joint doctorates
- Industrial Doctorates: Minimum 50% of the fellowship duration spent at the non-academic sector



MSCA DN 2022: Eligible Participants

Who Applies?

- Consortia of universities, research institutions, businesses including SMEs and other non academic actors like NGOs, Charities, Hospitals, government institutions, etc.
- At least **three independent legal entities**, each established in a different MS or AC; minimum of 1 beneficiary from a MS (on top of this minimum, any entity from any third country can join; no minimum for associated partners)



MSCA DN 2022: Eligible participants



EU COUNTRIES

- Member States (MS) including their outermost regions
- The Overseas Countries and Territories (OCTs) linked to the MS.



NON-EU COUNTRIES

- Countries associated to Horizon Europe (AC)
- Low and middle income countries: See <u>HE</u> <u>Programme Guide</u>.
- Other countries when announced in the call or exceptionally if their participation is essential



SPECIFIC CASES

- Affiliated entities established in countries eligible for funding.
- EU bodies
- International organisations (IO):
 - International European research organisations are eligible for funding.
 - Other IO are not eligible (only exceptionally if participation is essential)
 - IO in a MS or AC are eligible for funding for Training and mobility actions and when announced in the call conditions



MSCA DN 2022: UK participation

- UK is to be considered as an Associated Country to Horizon Europe in the frame of these calls.
- For DN: partners located in UK can be beneficiary and the doctoral candidate(s) recruited by UK partners are taken into account in the count of person-months funded by the EC (max 360 or 540 months depending on the DN mode)
- If the HE association agreement between UK and the EC is not signed by the signature of the DN 2022 Grant Agreements, successful UK applicants will receive funding from UKRI.
- Currently the UK government guarantee only covers those eligible calls where the grant agreement needs to be signed by 31 December 2022.

MSCA DN 2022: Switzerland participation

- Switzerland is to be considered as an Third Country not associated to Horizon Europe in the frame of these calls.
- For DN: partners located in Switzerland cannot be "Beneficiary". They can be involved as "Associated Partner". However, they can recruit doctoral candidates on their own funds (SERI funding).
- If an association agreement between Switzerland and the EC is signed by the deadline for submission of DN calls for proposals, the status of Switzerland will evolve (from Third Country not associated to HE to associated country to HE)

MSCA DN 2022: Eligible participants

Academic sector

- ✓ public or private higher education establishments
- ✓ public or private nonprofit research organisations
- ✓ International European Research Organisations

Non-academic sector

 ✓ any socioeconomic actor not included in the academic sector

MSCA DN 2022: Eligible researchers

- Supported researchers must be **doctoral candidates** (not already in possession of a doctoral degree at the date of recruitment)
- Researchers must be enrolled in a doctoral programme, in at least 1 EU Member State/Associated Country (at least 2 for Joint Doctorates)
- For Industrial Doctorates, candidate must spend minimum 50% of fellowship at non-academic partner.
- Any nationality.
- **Mobility rule**: must not have resided or carried out main activity in the country of the recruiting beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before their recruitment date.



MSCA DN 2022: Industrial Doctorates (I)



- Since beneficiaries **must** recruit, ID fellows had two consecutive contracts by the academic and non-academic partners, respectively.
- In some countries/cases, this created issues for fellows and/or hosts.
- As of 2022 call, amendment to give flexibility:
- ✓ Remove obligation of non-academic partner to be beneficiary.
- ✓ Remove the 1/3 upper limit of secondment to allow fellow to spend at least 50% at non-academic.



MSCA DN 2022: Industrial Doctorates (II)



✓ For DN-ID, it is possible to have doctoral candidates recruited in the academic sector for 100% of their time, and sent on secondments to non-academic participants for at least 50% of the time.

- ✓ It is also possible to have doctoral candidates recruited in the non-academic sector for 100% of their time, and sent on secondments to academic participants for up to 50% of the time.
- Non-academic participants that host secondments but do not recruit can only be associated partners.

✓ Possible to propose multiple recruitments.





MSCA DN 2022: Resubmissions

Novelty for 2022 call

- Resubmission restrictions: applicants having received a score below 80% in the DN 2021 call are not eligible to resubmit a similar proposal in the DN 2022 call.
- As specified in the submission forms Part A, a "Similar" proposal or contract is one that differs from the current one in minor ways, and in which some of the present consortium members are involved.


