
Mission


ECHOES' mission is to set up the **European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage (ECCCH)**, a shared platform designed to facilitate collaboration among heritage professionals and researchers, providing them with access to data, scientific resources, training, and advanced digital tools tailored to suit their needs.



ECHOES and **ECCCH**

- ECCCH: flagship initiative of Horizon Europe to help the CH sector to take full advantage of the opportunities of the digital transition.
- ECHOES is a EU funded project whose mission is to set up the ECCCH the Cultural Heritage Cloud integrating the results of all ECCCH-funded projects from the 2023-2025 EU calls.
- The EC has explicitly requested ECHOES to be the Single Entry Point (SEP) for stakeholders, to highlight the coherence of the CH Cloud initiative.
- All ECCCH-funded projects are members of a larger community coordinated by ECHOES.






ECHOES in Numbers

ECHOES in Numbers

ECHOES' consortium includes 15 umbrella organisations representing more than
 1000 organisations in Europe, and a variety of disciplines:

art, archaeology, language as social monuments and archives, libraries and cultural data museums sites cultural digital cultural conservationintangible heritage management, and more restoration heritage media culture

 During the construction of the project, ECHOES received 240 expressions of interest from various Cultural Heritage stakeholders in 36 EU and non-EU countries



Strategic objectives

- Build an open-source infrastructure that enables the creation of practical applications driven by CH communities' needs
- 2. Move away from an object-focused approach to a holistic approach to digital transformation of both tangible and intangible assets
- 3. Bring together fragmented communities within the CH sector into a new cohesive community




Strategic objectives

- 4. Integrate results of past, current and future ECCCHrelated projects regarding data, services, digital processes and applications
- 5. Deliver a sustainable and inclusive legal entity that handles the development, deployment, and maintenance of the ECCCH platform
- 6. Enable and foster innovative, collaborative co-creation of new knowledge around the Digital Commons



The Digital Commons


- ECHOES must set up the European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage (ECCCH) by involving the National initiatives for Cultural Heritage.
- ECCCH should also interact with the
 Data Space for Cultural Heritage and
 the European Open Science Cloud
 (EOSC). ECHOES' vision is that these 3
 European initiatives should come
 together around the new concept of
 Digital Commons.



The Digital Commons

ECHOES will create a Digital
 Continuum, based on a Digital
 Ecosystem, which will empower users
 to interact with, manipulate and enrich
 Digital Twins, leading to new, jointly
 developed scientific knowledge.

 This digital environment will allow the creation of a new generation of heritage objects, the **Digital Commons**, which are semantically rich and collectively produced.



ECHOES Pillars



Community Pillar

Aims to build and organise the ECCCH community by leveraging the various sectors of CH and provides essential training to facilitate the adoption and use of the Cloud.



Knowledge Pillar

Responsible for creating the cloud infrastructure and setting up the CH Knowledge Base.



Innovation Pillar

Focuses on the development of user-friendly vertical applications and on the assessment of the ECCCH digital ecosystem.



Sustainability Pillar

Aims to establish a legal entity to ensure the cloud's economic, social, and environmental sustainability, securing its leadership both in the EU and globally.




Transversal Pillar

Includes all the activities dedicated to management and communication, as well as enhancing collaboration and integrating data and tools from various projects and complementary initiatives.


ECHOES cascading grants

- ECHOES Cascading Grants Programme will allow the testing of tools and applications developed outside the consortium to integrate them into the ECCCH
- Three Open Calls will be published:
 - Call 1: Data (expected to be published in February 2025 12 projects, 60.000 € per project)
 - Call 2: Engagement and Collaboration (expected to be published in Autumn 2025 20 projects, 30.000 € per project)
 - Call 3: Data and Vertical Applications (expected to be published in Autumn 2026 18 projects, 60.000 € per project)


ECHOES and the Data Space for CH

What is the relationship between ECHOES and the common European data space for cultural heritage?

- The data space serves as the main EU entry point for access to CH data, for use and reuse by large audiences, including educators, creatives and citizens, as well as by other sectors and other data spaces.
- ECHOES aims to create Digital Commons that integrates services and tools to form a comprehensive virtual environment for CH professionals.
- Through interoperable frameworks, data from the data space will flow securely to ECHOES for heritage professionals to work with, while research outputs and data generated in ECHOES will be accessible through the data space for reuse across various sectors.
- Other Data Spaces (e.g. the Data Space for Tourism) might be integrated in the process of developing the Cultural Heritage Cloud.
