- La Comisión Europea nos informa sobre un error relativo al **Gender Equality Plan: Issue concerning the Gender Equality Plan (GEP)**

*There was a mistake in the IT implementation of the eligibility criterion on gender equality plans (GEPs). They become obligatory only for calls with deadline after 1.1.2022.*

*Due to a technical issue, the check for existence of a GEP has been activated for all projects entering grant preparation in 2022 The issue is now corrected. In case your beneficiaries (from 2021 calls) still see the error message 'gender plan missing', they should re-apply the*

'validate' button. In the unlikely event that the issue persists, they should contact the service desk.

- **Nueva versión de las Plantillas en Horizonte Europa**

A new version of the [generic proposal templates](#) for Horizon Europe is now available on the Funding & Tenders Portal. It includes changes in the proposal part B template, taking into account feedback from participants and stakeholders after the first calls of Horizon Europe. These changes focus on the tables in section 3 of proposal part B, which have been adapted to avoid duplication of information. In addition, the points in the impact section have been re-organised. Moreover, definitions of the different roles of participating organisation have been added in proposal part A.

**Please note that participants, when actually preparing a proposal, have to use a call/topic specific template provided directly in the submission system.** Calls/topics for which the submission system is already configured (i.e. currently open and soon to be opened) provide the previous version of the proposal template and applicants to those calls have to use this previous version.

- **Consulta Preliminar al Mercado del Proyecto europeo de compra pública pre comercial iProcureSecurity [España], FERIA SICUR 2022 – IFEMA, 22 de febrero de 15.30 a 17.30h, Auditorio 1**

El Centro de Emergencias 061 de la Junta de Andalucía y SERMAS de la Comunidad de Madrid son dos de los nueve compradores públicos del proyecto de Horizonte2020 iProcureSecurity PCP. El proyecto tiene como objetivo desarrollar sistemas innovadores de gestión del triaje que puedan reforzar la resistencia y la interoperabilidad de los servicios médicos de emergencia en Europa. Para ello, los contratantes del proyecto ofrecen unos 6,7 millones de euros a las empresas (futuros proveedores) interesados en realizar actividades de investigación y desarrollo (I+D) con ese fin. El proceso se lleva a cabo como una contratación pre comercial (PCP) tras unas fases de I+D competitivas.

Como parte del proceso, el proyecto está organizando eventos de consulta preliminar al mercado (CPM) para explicar a los potenciales solicitantes la oportunidad de financiación, el instrumento PCP y los resultados esperados.

El Centro de Emergencias 061 de la Junta de Andalucía y SERMAS de la Comunidad de Madrid han organizado **un evento de consulta preliminar al mercado el próximo 22 de febrero en el marco del FORO SICUR 2022 dirigido a los proveedores españoles de las soluciones previstas (también se organizará un evento de CPM a nivel internacional)**.
