HORIZON-WIDERA-2023-ERA-01-01:

Programme level collaboration between national R&I policy-makers call aims to enhance the coordination and alignment of national and regional research and innovation (R&I) policies and funding programs, thereby strengthening the ERA and contributing to the EU's broader R&I goals.







- 2. Ensure that the consortium has the necessary expertise and complementary skills to achieve the project's objectives.




























































Identification of common R&I priorities developed considering international scenarios and trends leading to the development of coordinated R&I funding agendas

- **PP1** Adoption of PR1 by +35 EU RFO and beyond, including at least 11 HE widening countries (7 currently members of PRIMA and 4 potential newcomers)
- PR1 PRIMA Strategic Plan will identify research and innovation priorities in managing resources and their interlinkages embracing other dimensions such as human and planetary health.



Implementation of joint activities supporting technology development, market introduction, regulatory aspects and societal uptake of results.

- PR2 Planned financial contributions committed by at least 19 PS ministers




